

Bushy Park Kiwi Crèche Sponsorship

The North Island brown kiwi is rapidly declining in numbers on the New Zealand mainland. The kiwi population halving every 10 years in areas where predators are not being controlled. Without conservation management, only about 10% of kiwi chicks on the mainland New Zealand survive their first six months, and just 5% reach adulthood, well short of the 20% survival needed for a population to increase. Bushy Park Sanctuary is part of a conservation programme called BNZ Operation Nest Egg. The success rate for the survival of young kiwi released back into the wild as part of this programme is 60%.
